OPERATING

NOTE: ALWAYS USE IN A WELL-VENTALATED AREA AND THIS OVEN IS FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY.

NOTE: A COMPLETE 5-MINUTE SHUTDOWN MUST BE OBSERVED BEFORE THE OVEN CAN BE RE-LIT.

- 1. Make sure oven gas has is attached to the propane tank securely.
- 2. Make sure the propane valve is turned ON.
- 3. Make sure the oven is plugged in.
- 4. Turn the black mode switch to HIGH or LOW.
- 5. Set the temperature knob to the desired setting.
- 6. Keep the red switch on auto stetting.

NOTE: BEFORE OVEN PILOT BURNER WILL LIGHT, ALL AIR MUST BE PURGED FROM THE PILOT.

7. You will hear a sparking sound. The oven is attempting to light the pilot burner. The sound is normal.

NOTE: THE BURNER MIGHT NOT LIGHT ON FIRST ATTEMPT.

- 8. If the "red indicating light" comes ON, the oven is calling for heat and the burner is ON.
- 9. When the "red indicating light" goes OFF, the oven is at temperature and the burner is off.
- 10. The "red indicating light" will cycle ON and OFF as the thermostat calls for heat.
- 11. When cooking is complete, turn the MODE Switch to the OFF position.
