

CHAFERS & URNS

OPERATING

1. Fill the water pan with 1"-2" of hot water. Check water pan when in use to ensure sufficient water is contained at all times.
2. Stainless steel food pans can be used for cooking. They can also be placed in the oven to keep food hot.
3. Remove the lid of the sterno and set the sterno container into the heat cup. Light sterno and adjust lid of heat cut approximately ½ open. The top of sterno holder can be opened and closed to adjust the sterno flame. One (1) can of sterno should last from 1 to 1-1/2 hours.
4. Light sterno approximately 20 minutes before food pan is placed in chafer unit.
5. Cover chafer unit once sterno is lit.
6. When sterno is empty, be careful – can is very hot, remove with care.

NOTES

1. Do not use without water.
2. Do not use anything but sterno type fuel in the burner.
3. Never use lighter fluid, gasoline, or kerosene.
4. Never light the burner unit before putting liquid into the water pan or urn.
Low flame is sufficient to maintain proper heat.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Before returning chafing dish, scrape and wash food pans. Wash chafing dish and urns in lukewarm water and mild detergent.
2. Do not use harsh abrasives.
