

## SELF SET TENTS

### MAN POWER

Two (2) installers should be able to assemble a Self-Set Tent in approximately thirty (30) minutes.

### TOOLS REQUIRED

SLEDGE HAMMER

### INSPECT SITE

Please consult your local utility company prior to installation. Prior to assembly be sure to look around the area for obstacles, pipes, wires, etc.

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## LAYOUT & CHECK

1. Layout at Site: Spread drop cloths and unroll canopy at exact position of desired finished assembly. Any sharp objects which must remain on site under the canopy should be padded and taped. Assemble side poles and lay straight out from each pole hole in canopy. Drive stake 1'-0" in from the end of each pole. The stake must be driven through the ring attached to each guy rope.
2. Raise Side Poles: Start at opposite corners. Insert side poles into pole holes and rise so that bottom of poles slants toward the center of canopy. Adjust the guy rope. Continue with other two (2) corners and then move to the sides.
3. Raise Center Pole: Assemble three-piece center pole and insert into center pole hole. Raise to upright position and tie off jump rope to pole.
4. Side Pole Adjustment: tighten guy ropes and then set side poles to upright position. Adjust pole positions and guy rope tensions to properly pull out canopy. Protective covers are recommended for all stakes.
5. Take Down: Loosen all guy ropes. Spread drop clothes. Reverse steps 1 through 4 for disassembly.

NOTE: CHECK GUY ROPES PERIODICALLY FOR TIGHTNESS AND GOOD CONDITION. STORE CANOPY IN A COOL AND DRY AREA AND NEVER STORE WHILE WET OR DAMP.
